Frequently Asked Questions

Where are you located?

The brumbies are from the Toolara/Tuan forests near Rainbow Beach/Tin Can Bay in Queensland.

What kind of horses are they?

Our brumbies are fresh from the wild. They are strong, intelligent, and adaptable horses that have proven themselves in many and varied disciplines. They range from chunky QH types to finer, flowy types.

Why are they being removed from the Forestry?

Brumbies are being removed from areas within the forestry where they frequently cross busy roads. Targeted management is being undertaken to reduce vehicle strikes and accidents, keeping road users and brumbies safe.

Mares/ Stallions

Mares may be in foal. If a brumby mare has a young foal at foot, they will be sold together. Colts/Stallions are usually gelded but can also be entire if coming straight from the trap yards.

What kind of facilities do I need to bring home a brumby?

Your brumby will require a secure, safe yard upon arrival. Steel or timber panels, a small paddock or other safely enclosed area where your brumby can acclimatize and receive more training before being allowed into a bigger paddock is recommended. Yarded brumbies will require access to fresh, quality hay and water.

How much are they?

Adoption fees for brumbies are between \$300 - \$500.

Can they be registered?

Yes, all brumbies sold through TBP are eligible for brumby registration through the Australian Brumby Horse Register (ABHR) and come with a certificate of capture.

Is transport for my brumby available?

Yes, local transport and transport towards Toowoomba may be available (depending on timing). A towable stock crate is also available for hire from Amamoor for \$150 per day. Brumbies will need to be free-loaded onto the crate/truck and floats are not suitable for transporting them.

Can you help me train my brumby?
